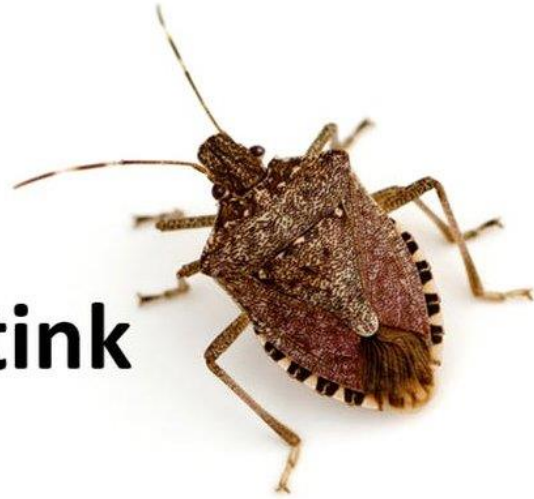

Brown Marmorated Stink Bug (BMSB)



The Australian Department of Agriculture and Water Resources (ADAWR) introduce seasonal import measures to manage the risk of the Brown Marmorated Stink Bug (BMSB) during the high risk season.

The measures apply to target high risk goods and target risk goods, shipped between 1 September 2018 and 30 April 2019, manufactured in- or shipped from:
USA, Italy, Germany, France, Russia, Greece, Hungary, Romania, Georgia and Japan.

Target high risk goods require mandatory treatment.

The following tariffs are categorized as target high risk goods:

36, 44, 45, 57, 68, 69, 70, 72, 73, 74, 75, 76, 78, 79, 80, 81, 82, 83, 84, 85, 86, 87, 88, 89 and 93.

Target risk goods are subject to increased onshore intervention through random inspection.

If the BMSB is detected, the goods will be directed for onshore treatment.

The following tariffs are categorized as target risk goods:

25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 31, 38, 39, 40, 46, 47, 48, 49 and 56.

During mentioned period, ANZSS require the following extra information for all bookings to Australia:

- Country of origin of the goods
- Country of manufacture of the goods
- Tariff code of the goods

If the goods originate from- and/or are manufactured in one of the mentioned countries and classify as target high risk goods, ANZSS require a treatment certificate from an ADAWR approved treatment provider.
